**Solemnity of All Saints YEAR A 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2014**

**Dear Parishioners,**

'Your reward will be great in heaven. The saints forever praise God's glory in heaven. The Baptismal Preparation Evenings for November will take place on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> at 8pm. in the Presbytery. All are welcome. A Meeting has been arranged for the Parents of those Children who are not attending a Catholic School and who wish to be prepared for their First Holy Communion. The Meeting will take place on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November at 7pm in the Presbytery. The actual preparation classes for the Children themselves will take place on Tuesday afternoons from 4.30pm-5.45pm during term-time, beginning on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> November. Also the Confirmation meetings for those youngsters not attending Catholic Schools will take place on Tuesday afternoons from 4.30pm-5.30pm starting Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November. All are welcome.

During the month of November we will offer a Novena of Masses for the Holy Souls. If you wish your deceased family members and friends to be included in this Novena of Masses please write out their names and place them in the envelopes provided in both porches, and return them to the Sacristy. You may include a small offering if you wish, as the envelopes will be opened. On Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> November there will be a Deanery Mass for the deceased Priests and Deacons of the Deanery at Holy Souls in Acocks Green at 12.00 midday. See note inside Newsletter.

A Parish meeting will be held on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> November at 7.30pm. All are welcome. If there are any topics for discussion please let Fr Dominic know as soon as possible so they can be added to the agenda. Please note on Tuesday there will only be a 10am Mass and on Thursday there will only be a Requiem Mass for Mrs Pat Brennan at 11am.
