The money will be used to fund a new physio exercise class recently introduced in Shirley for local MS sufferers. The triathlon will take place in Sutton Park and will comprise a mile swim (in the lake), a 24 mile bike ride, followed by a 6 mile run - which should take about 4 hours in total. Helen's father, Jim, who was a member of this parish, suffered with MS for over 40 years, and was looked after through all of that time by his wife Norah, who is still a parish member. Helen said "I have never taken part in an Olympic triathlon before, but I've been training all year, so hoping I'll be able to complete it.
