For the present moment we are reflecting on the role of the family, in particular 'The Vocation and Mission of the Family in the Church and in the Contemporary World.' This Wednesday, February 18th, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Season of Lent. Please note that we have Mass at 10am; 12.30pm; and 7pm. For the 7pm evening Mass we have obtained free car-parking in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park.
