Dear Parishioners,

'Christ's death is our ransom. God showed His love for us by sending His Son to be our brother. Christ shows His and our love for the Father by giving His life in atonement for our sins. He is our high priest who has entered the highest heavens but not before experiencing the depth of human suffering.'

It is this good news that we celebrate on this World Mission Sunday. We are reminded that we are to be missionaries because of our baptism; and to be missionary is to have a passion for Jesus and for His people. There will be a second collection for 'Missio', the Church's official charity for overseas Mission. Gift Aid envelopes are available. The baptismal preparation evenings for November will take place on Thursday 12th and Thursday 19th November at 8pm in the Presbytery. All are welcome. Churches Together in Central Solihull are organizing a Halloween Walk to pray for the Civic Life and activities in Solihull. It will take place on Saturday 31st October, starting at 6pm from the Methodist Church. You are invited to participate and to bring with you some form of light, e.g. a candle in a jar, or a torch. We look forward to welcoming Mr. Anthony Hofler who will be leading the 'Journeying Together in Faith' Meetings for the next three weeks on Thursday evenings at 7.30pm in the Parish Hall. Anthony's first two talks will be on 'Secular Britain and the Task of the Laity: what has the Church said?' There are some hand outs available which include an article Anthony wrote for the Catholic Times. Father Frank wishes to thank all those who made last Friday evening's celebrations such a special occasion for his family and himself. 'Once more we were over whelmed by the love, support and generosity of St Augustine's. May God continue to bless your very special community.' A Mass for the deceased Clergy of the Deanery will take place on Tuesday 10th November at 12.00 midday, at Holy Souls, Acocks Green. Please come along and support this event.

Following on from last week's Pastoral Letter from the Archbishop, the Chair of Caritas Archdiocese of Birmingham has written with some further details.
