SOLEMNITY of The Most HOLY TRINITY YEAR C 22nd May 2016

Dear Parishioners,

'On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the liturgy invites us to praise God not merely for the wonders that He has worked, but for who He is; for the beauty and goodness of His being from which His action stems. We are invited to contemplate, so to speak, the Heart of God, His deepest reality which is His being One in the Trinity , a supreme and profound communion of love and life.' (Pope Benedict XVI) .**This Sunday afternoon we** have the Rosary rally at St Augustine's, starting at 2pm with a Holy Hour. At 3pm we will celebrate Mass and at the end of Mass we will have a May Procession. We would be delighted to welcome our children and young Parishioners to the Rally, especially the Mass and Procession. Please bring some blossom or petals for strewing in front of Our Lady's statue. Special welcome to Father Anselm, a Cistercian Monk, from Mount St Bernard's Abbey in Leicestershire. Father Anselm will be the main celebrate at the 3pm Mass.

The Baptismal preparation evenings for June will take place on Thursday 2nd and 9th June at 8pm in the Presbytery. **Maryvale Catechetical Centre** is hosting a Sacred Heart Novena and Pilgrimage from Thursday 26th May until Friday 3rd June. Each evening there will be the opportunity to make a small pilgrimage by passing through the Door of Mercy with Confession available from 7pm-7.45pm followed by Mass at 8pm. The Pilgrimage afternoon will be on Sunday 5th June with Mass at 3pm celebrated by Bishop Robert Byrne, followed by a procession of the Blessed Sacrament.

Our CAFOD Summer Fayre will take place on Saturday 2nd July from 1.30pm-3.30pm. There will be a short Meeting this Thursday morning, 26th May, to prepare for the Fayre.
