SOLEMNITY OF SS PETER AND PAUL 28th June 2015 YEAR B

Dear Parishioners,

'The Keys of the Kingdom Christ promised to remain forever with His Church through Peter the head of the apostles. The Lord rescued Peter from the hatred of Herod and always comes to the aid of His Church against which the forces of evil will never win. Paul is the apostle of the Gentiles so that the Good News is spread throughout the whole world. Christ is with us too as we witness to His power in our lives.
