Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord 2nd April 2023

Dear Parishioners, 'Jesus is King! The triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem gives way to his passion and death. Yet Jesus is King and within a week will rise triumphant from the dead. He is the firm ground of our hope that all sufferings in this life are lost in the power of his resurrection.' (Pope Saint John Sunday Missal.)

Father Dominic writes: 'Dear Parishioners, Father Joseph, Deacon Kevin and I look forward to the celebrations of Holy week and pray that you will find the opportunity to participate prayerfully in the events of this Holy Week.

This Sunday afternoon at 3pm in Church we will celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. We will welcome Parishioners from Our Lady of the Wayside and from St George and St Teresa's. Free car parking has been requested for the lower level of the Dominion Car Park. **On Tuesday evening** we will have a shared Penance Service at St George and St Teresa's in Dorridge at 7pm. All are welcome. **On Wednesday** the Mass of Chrism at St Chad's Cathedral is at 11.30am. You are welcome to attend this Mass.

On Maundy Thursday there will be only one Mass, the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7pm. After the Mass there will be Watching at the Altar of Repose until 11pm. There will be a Holy Hour from 8.30pm-9.30pm. Free car parking has been requested in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park until 11.15pm. **On Good Friday** we have Family Stations of the Cross at 10am All families are welcome. At 11am we have an Ecumenical Walk of Witness, starting outside St Augustine's Church. All are welcome.

The Commemoration of the Lord's Passion takes place at 3pm on Good Friday afternoon. This service will include Veneration of the Cross and the distribution of Holy Communion. On the evening of Good Friday we have Stations of the Cross at 7pm. Free car parking has been requested for the Stations of the Cross in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park. On Holy Saturday we will have Morning Prayers and Rosary at 10am. Please note, there will not be a 12.30pm Mass on Holy Saturday. The Easter Vigil will take place at 8pm to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. 'Seven Last Words of Jesus' Reflection 6

'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.' 'It was now about the sixth hour and, with the sun eclipsed, a darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour. The veil of the Temple was torn right down the middle; and when Jesus had cried out in a loud voice, he said, 'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.' With these words he breathed his last.' (Luke 23: 44-6) 'In Jesus Christ our lives... find their true meaning. He who became one of us, lived as we do, has made holy all that we are and all that we do, except of course, when we sin.' 'Our joys and laughter, our daily tasks, as well as our suffering and death are now holy things, sanctified because He has touched them.' If we are willing, 'the divine life first given to us at our Baptism will grow, and it is often through pain and suffering that this happens.' Our daily trials and difficulties, our suffering and death all 'have within them the joy of resurrection.' Our Good Friday experiences will lead us 'to a greater understanding of and sharing in the joys and triumph of Easter Sunday.' Jesus' words, 'Into your hands I commit my spirit,' can be our prayer too. Suffering of any kind can become a means of surrender to God. 'Into your hands I commit my spirit.' These words have been uttered by men and women down the ages, in their daily struggles and anxieties. In their pain and in their death. We cannot, and must not of course, rejoice in suffering, this would be to do violence to our very nature, but we can 'rejoice in the carrying of our cross.' It must however 'be for His sake, to be like Christ and so with Him, He in us and we in Him.'

Prayer

Dear God, at times of suffering, help us to kiss the crucifix, And so, 'discover Him, who suffered like us and for us.' Help us as we pray, 'Father into your hands I commit my spirit', Then our yoke 'will be sweeter, our burden lighter.' Amen.

In the carrying of our cross, we can discover 'the secret of the resurrection – that new life comes from the dying seed.' This reflection is with reference to, and with quotations from 'Seven Last Words,' by Cardinal Basil Hume. The prayer is an adaptation of the Cardinal's words.
