Dear Parishioners, We are reminded that we have the potential freedom to be good, rich, productive soil. We beg that the Word will return to us again and again, so that we can do His will, achieving the end for which God sends Him to us.' (Magnificat).

This weekend, we have a second collection for Stella Maris, (formerly Apostleship of the Sea). There are Gift Aid envelopes available in both porches. On this day we pause to remember the seafarers who sustain global trade and often work far from home, and we support the pastoral and practical care offered to them around the world. The disruption to shipping in the Strait of Hormuz resulted in an estimated 20,000 seafarers stranded on board ships, facing heightened risk and considerable mental strain. Sadly, several have also been killed.
