**READER:** We pray for us all as we enter Holy Week. As we reflect on Jesus' total gift of himself during the coming days, may we be filled with the hope of Easter.

READER: We remember all who are sick, those in hospital and those who are housebound. Let us ask Mary the Mother of the Lord to pray with us: as we say- Hail Mary...Now let us pray for a few moments in silence for our own needs and intentions and for those intentions placed in the prayer box.

PRIEST: Lord of life and hope, as we celebrate Palm Sunday, may we also look forward to the joy of the resurrection. May we walk this coming week in your company. Amen.
