

ST JOHN EUDES, PRIEST; MEMORIAL: AUGUST 19th

St John Eudes was born in France in 1601 and lived most of his life in Normandy. He founded the Institute of Our Lady of Charity to help prostitutes, and the Congregation of Jesus and Mary, whose work was the running of seminaries, which he established at Caen, Coutances, Lisieux and Rouen. He left spiritual writings, and promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and of Mary



If the Church shows respect and veneration for everything that came in contact with the Saviour's Body: the Cross, the Nails, the Thorns, the Winding Sheet of His Sepuchre, the Swathing-bands of His infancy and similar things – what honour must be due to this venerable body of the Blessed Virgin from which the Body of the Redeemer was formed!"
