### Dear Parishioners,

**Father Dominic writes**: 'Dear Parishioners, Father Joseph, Deacon Kevin and I wish you many joyful blessings on this third Sunday of Advent, traditionally known as 'Gaudete Sunday'. This name is taken from the entrance antiphon of today's Mass: 'Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say, rejoice! The Lord is near.'

On Thursday December 17<sup>th</sup> at 7pm, we are holding a Penance Service and will be joined by our neighbouring Priests and Parishioners. You are most welcome and we have requested free car parking in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park. The Penance Service will consist of Scripture Readings, an Examination of Conscience and Individual Confession.

**Father Joseph and I** visited Fr Paul last Saturday and found him in very good form. He wishes to be remembered to you and continues to rely on your prayers, as we all do.

**Pope Francis** has asked that this year from December 8<sup>th</sup> 2020 until December 8<sup>th</sup> 2021 will be a year dedicated to Saint Joseph. With the Apostolic Letter 'Patris Corde' (With a Father's Heart) Pope Francis recalls the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the universal Church.'


