May this be a beginning to an end of the suffering of the past year and a new beginning to a future of justice and of peace. We give thanks to the negotiators who have worked tirelessly for this outcome. The ceasefire begins this Sunday, Peace Sunday. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response Lord graciously hear us.

**READER:** We pray for ourselves. As we hear Mary's appeal, 'do whatever he tells you', we pray for the generosity and commitment to make a difference in the lives of the people we meet. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response Lord graciously hear us.
