READER: In our longing to see you, we pray for ourselves as we start our Advent journey towards Christmas. May our loving Lord be our light, our hope, our love, our beginning and our end. May we support each other as we travel towards Bethlehem.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.
