Dear Parishioners,

'**The coming of the Holy Spirit on the Church**. The message 'Jesus is Lord' must be preached to every corner of the earth. We cannot do this unless we receive the Holy Spirit. Today we pray that we may be open to the power of the Spirit and that He will come and fill the hearts of the faithful.'(Pope Saint John Sunday Missal.)

Father Dominic writes: 'Dear Parishioners, Father Joseph, Deacon Kevin and I, join in wishing you a very joyful Feast of Pentecost- the birthday of the Church. May this Feast bring us such blessed assurance that we are God's beloved children and heirs to eternal life and happiness.

Some of the Bishops have written a pastoral letter for Pentecost highlighting our responsibility to care for creation. Copies of the letter are available in both porches and on the Parish website.

After this weekend, we return to Ordinary Time in the Liturgy. Ordinary Time resumes at week 8, Psalter Week 4, Weekday cycle of Readings Year 1. Next Sunday is celebrated as Trinity Sunday and the Sunday after that is Corpus Christi. This Thursday, May 27th, is our Patronal Feast Day, St Augustine of England. The Mass at 10am will be a public Mass. Volunteers will be welcome to help clean the Church afterwards. On Saturday May 29th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Dedication of the Church.


