WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

The elderly are signs of hope and witnesses of blessedness. The theme of the first Message of Pope Leo XIV for the *World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly*, whose fifth edition will be celebrated on Sunday, 27 July 2025 is "**Blessed are those who have not lost hope (Sir 14:2)**" and fits into the context of the Jubilee of Hope 2025. In the Message, the Holy Father invites us to recognise the elderly not only as recipients of pastoral care, but as witnesses of hope who are active protagonists in the life of the Church.

Old age can be a time of blessedness in which hope, tested in the fire of a long life, becomes a source of joy and renewed trust in the Lord. God "teaches us that, in his eyes, old age is a time of blessing and grace, and that the elderly are, for him, the first witnesses of hope.' states Pope Leo XIV in his *Message*'

Lord Jesus, you were born of the Virgin Mary,
