Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord Year A 29th March 2026

You are invited to St Alphege Church this Sunday afternoon, March 29th, for a Vespers Recital. Choruses from Handel's Messiah at 5pm. **You are also invited to** Sung Vespers on Holy Wednesday, 1st April at 7pm, at English Martyr's Church, Evelyn Road, Sparkhill B11 3JN.

This Tuesday evening, 31st March, Mothers' Prayers are leading us in the Stations of the Cross at 8pm. All are welcome. **On Maundy Thursday the only Mass** will be the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.00pm. There will be Watching at the Altar of Repose until 11.00. Holy Hour 9.00-11.00pm

On Good Friday, we have Family Stations of the Cross at 10am. We welcome our families.

At 11am on Good Friday, we have an ecumenical Walk of Witness, starting at St Augustine's and finishing at the flower stand in Mell Square.

The main celebration on Good Friday will be the Commemoration of our Lord's Passion at 3pm. The traditional collection for the Holy Places is taken towards the end of this Service. This collection is specially needed at this time, given the situation in the Holy Land.

On Holy Saturday, there will not be the usual 12.30pm Mass. The Easter Vigil will take place at 8pm. On Easter Sunday Mass will be celebrated at 9am and 11am.

We have requested free car parking in the lower level of the Dominion Car Park for the following days and times: Tuesday 31st March 7.30pm-9.15pm; Maundy Thursday 6.30pm-11.15pm; Good Friday 6.30pm-8pm for Stations of the Cross; Holy Saturday 7.15pm-10.30pm. On Easter Sunday, the usual permission for the upper level of the Dominion Car Park is in place.

Please pray for all who are under instruction in order to be Received into the Church, including Yvonne Harris who will be baptised and received into Full Communion at the Easter Vigil. The next baptismal preparation evening will take place on Thursday 16th April between 7.30pm-9pm in the Presbytery. Please inform Mrs Mary Clark or one of the Clergy, if you wish to attend.

The Lenten Penance Service will take place on Monday 30th March at 7pm, at Olton Friary Church. Please note that there will not be 'Lectio Divina' this week on Wednesday; neither will there be a Prayer Meeting on Thursday.
