PRIEST: Gracious Lord, we come before you with grateful and faithful hearts, seeking your presence in this moment, asking for your guidance, wisdom and peace. Open our minds and hearts to your word and lead us in your truth.

READER: We pray for Pope Francis and for all religious leaders throughout the world; that they might be guided by wisdom and inspire those whom they lead in the ways of truth, justice, compassion and mercy.

(Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

READER: Wednesday sees the Memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels; in our prayers we ask God to send angels of peace to the troubled places of the world.
