READER: Let us pray that we may embrace this Advent season as a time of sincere repentance, preparing our hearts to receive the Savior with renewed faith and love. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

READER: For pray for our nation: that the Lord may guide the minds of those who govern, in order to promote the common good and assure justice for all. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response: Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We pray that those touched by shadows of bereavement, may feel themselves close to their dear ones, through him whose light even death could not overcome.
