(Pause) Lord hear us. Response Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We pray for those members of our community that serve as our own shepherds and wise men. We give thanks to those that guide and nourish us and those that inspire and teach us. (Pause) Lord hear us. Response Lord graciously hear us.

READER: We pray that those touched by shadows of bereavement, may feel themselves close to their dear ones, through him whose light even death could not overcome.
